

Job Title	Network Technician

Grade	Grade 4
Purpose	Working as part of a team, or as an individual, the job holder will carry out operational or support duties, involving routine activities. The job holder will carry out maintenance, repair and replacement of Electrical & Instrumentation systems on gas pressure control installations and associated equipment.
	The job holder will be responsible for the maintenance of the Electrical & Instrumentation systems on the high-pressure gas supply network.
Key Accountabilities	 Carry out all work on the Network safely and cost effectively, keeping up to date with current technical and industry standards and future developments which may be of an individual specialist nature, as a team leader or as a coordinator of a number of teams/ individuals.
	 Maintain accurate records of all activities to satisfy Network Services, Wales & West Utilities, third party and legislative requirements
	 Prepare reports and provide information, guidance and advice to Network Services management and third-party customers on technical matters relating to the Network.
	Oversee activities carried out by Contractors/Direct Labour where necessary and appropriate.
	Undertake and oversee all installation, commissioning, maintenance, validation, modification, repair and calibration work in accordance with appropriate policies, procedures and statutory requirements to ensure optimum technical performance and reliability of equipment.
	 Participate in the design and costing of minor modifications.
	Work within and promote the philosophy of team working and development across all activities in order to achieve business objectives and improve performance,
	 In carrying out these duties, the job holder shall comply with the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 by taking
